How are your pieces finished?

We use George's Club House Wax Food Safe Wood Finish on all of our Signature Series work. This wax was made by a woodworker who wanted to have



an absolutely food safe finish, chemical free finish for wood. We use this because we believe in the hypoallergenic properties of this finish and it is a wonderful compliment to our Wood Art Jewelry.

Where does the wood come from?

The Signature Series works of Art is made from FSC certified wood.

FSC is an independent, non-governmental, not-for-profit organization established to promote the responsible

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management of the world's forests.

FSC is one of two global forest certification system established for forests and forest products. This voluntary market driven mechanism can be regarded as one of the most important initiatives of the last decade to promote better forest management.

Why is this Eco-Friendly?

The **One of kind Wood art Jewelry** I create is constructed for salvaged woods. Some of the wood come from other craftsmen such as Norm E. Sartorius who was kind enough to offer some of the most wonderful scrap pieces I have seen.

The Signature Series works of art are Eco-Friendly. A traditional material merged with a new technology to create this new aesthetic in jewelry. Thanks to cutting edge technology, we are able to **lessen the impact of jewelry making on our natural resources**. We save an average of 70-80% of the wood normally used to create such a sculptural work.
